Beginners Lead Rein (BLR), Lead Rein (LR), 1st Year Novice (1YN) & Novice (N) Classes

Ring One –Judging to start at **9am** prompt

Young Handler £3.00 (Running in the following order BLR, LR, 1YN, N)

Ridden £3.00 (BLR, LR, 1YN, N)

Break for lunch

Fancy Dress £2.00 (one class for all competitors)

4 x Gymkhana Games £8.00 (BLR, LR, 1YN, N)

Ring Two - Opening at **9am** and running all morning

Handy Pony (all sections running concurrently) £2.00

Ring Three - Opening at **9am** and running all morning

Clear Round Jumping (Open to all competitors) £2.00

Rider decides height before starting course. Max. height 1'3". If the competitor does not achieve a clear round they may pay £1 to have one more attempt.

Young Handler will be judged on handlers ability, obedience of horse/pony and overall impression (including leader)

Ridden will be judged on rider's position, aids and effectiveness, the horse/pony's way of going and obedience and overall impression (including leader)

Please Note

- Competitors may enter one section only – Beginners Lead Rein, Lead Rein, 1st Year Novice, Novice or Open (to be held Sunday 29th August).
- For the purposes of this part of the event, 'Novice' is a description of the rider's ability, not the horse's ability. There are Novice Horse/Pony classes at the Open event (Sun. 29th Aug.)
- All competitors must wear a hat to the correct safety standard. (PAS015, BSEN 1384 or ASTM F1163 with BSI Kite Mark).
- All competitors must wear a body protector when jumping.
- The show organisers reserve the right to amend/amalgamate classes depending on entries.
- Competitors will not receive their number until all entry fees have been paid.
- All competitors to walk and trot only with the exception of Clear Round Jumping. Novice competitors in the Ridden class may show canter in their individual show, if they feel safe to do so.
- Up to 6 championship points will be awarded in Young Handler, Ridden and Handy Pony classes according to placings, i.e. 6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd, etc. Similarly, points will be awarded for each gymkhana game to calculate the Games Championship. Overall championship points will then be awarded for games according to Games Championship placings, i.e. 6 points to games champion, 5 points to reserve games champion, etc. Placings in Fancy Dress and Clear Round Jumping do not count towards the Overall Championship.
- The Megan Chapman Award for Effort will be presented to the competitor in any section with the most points but who has not won a 1st place.
- Any person displaying unsafe or unsportsmanlike behaviour will be asked to leave the showground.
- A photographer may be taking photos at this event. These photos may be used for publicity.
