Notes

- Turnout to be judged on cleanliness and tidiness of horse/pony, tack & rider and overall impression.
- Novice Horse/Pony is for young and/or inexperienced horses/ponies and will be judged similarly to the Ridden class. Competitors will not be asked to canter together but may show canter in their individual show.
- Ridden to be judged on rider's position, aids & effectiveness, way of going & obedience of horse/pony and overall impression.
- Working Hunter to be judged on jumping ability, boldness over fences, individual show and overall impression.
- In-Hand to be judged on horse/pony's condition, conformation, movement and overall impression.
- Up to 6 championship points will be awarded in Turnout, In-Hand, Ridden, Working Hunter and Show Jumping classes according to placings, i.e. 6 points for 1st, 5 points for 2nd, etc.
Similarly, points will be awarded for each gymkhana game to calculate the Games Championship. Overall championship points will then be awarded for games according to Games Championship placings, i.e. 6 points to games champion, 5 points to reserve games champion, etc.
Placings in Novice Ridden, Best in Show and Shetland Gallop do not count towards the Points Championships.
- The Melanie Moncrieff Award for Effort will be presented to the competitor in either section with the most points but who has not won a 1st place.
- A photographer may be taking photos at this event. These photos may be used for publicity.

Rules

- Anybody who has previously competed in the lead rein or novice(rider) classes of the Shetland Horse & Pony Event this year may not compete in the open classes.
- All competitors must wear a hat to the correct safety standard. (PAS015, BSEN 1384 or ASTM F1163 with BSI Kite Mark).
- All competitors under 16 years of age must wear a body protector when jumping and in the Shetland Gallop. (We recommend that all senior competitors wear a body protector when jumping)
- The show organisers reserve the right to amend/amalgamate classes depending on entries.
- Competitors will not receive their number until all entry fees have been paid.
- Any person displaying unsafe or unsportsmanlike behaviour will be asked to leave the showground.
